

All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE)

The All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE) is a national level entrance exam conducted by the Sainik Schools Society for admission to classes 6th and 9th in 33 Sainik Schools located in different parts of India. In this article, we will discuss the age and qualification criteria and the exam syllabus for AISSEE in India.

Age Criteria:

For admission to Class 6th, the age of the candidate should be between 10 to 12 years as on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought. For admission to Class 9th, the age of the candidate should be between 13 to 15 years as on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought.

Qualification Criteria:

For admission to Class 6th, the candidate must have passed Class 5th from a recognized school. For admission to Class 9th, the candidate must have passed Class 8th from a recognized school. In addition, candidates must meet the physical and medical standards specified by the Sainik Schools Society.

Exam Syllabus:

The AISSEE is a pen-and-paper-based test consisting of multiple-choice questions. The exam is conducted in two papers - Paper I and Paper II.

Paper I:

The paper is for candidates seeking admission to Class 6th and consists of questions from the following subjects:

1. Mathematics - 50 Marks
2. Language - 25 Marks
3. General Knowledge - 25 Marks

Paper II:

The paper is for candidates seeking admission to Class 9th and consists of questions from the following subjects:

1. Mathematics - 50 Marks
2. Science - 25 Marks
3. Social Studies - 25 Marks

The duration of each paper is 2.5 hours. The question paper is designed to test the candidate's ability in Mathematics, Language, General Knowledge, Science, and Social Studies.

The AISSEE is a national level entrance exam for admission to Sainik Schools in India. The age and qualification criteria are different for admission to Class 6th and 9th. The exam syllabus consists of Mathematics, Language, General Knowledge, Science, and Social Studies. Candidates should prepare thoroughly for the exam to secure admission to one of the prestigious Sainik Schools in India.
