

Rashtriya Military School (RMS)

The Rashtriya Military School (RMS) entrance exam is conducted by the Ministry of Defence, Government of India, for admission to Class 6th and 9th in five military schools in India. The schools are located in Ajmer, Bangalore, Belgaum, Chail, and Dholpur. In this article, we will discuss the age and qualification criteria and the exam syllabus for the RMS exam in India.

Age Criteria:

The age criteria for the RMS exam in India are as follows:

1. For Class 6th: The candidate should be between 10 to 12 years of age as on 31st March of the year in which admission is sought.

Candidates who qualify for the written exam will be called for the Interview, which is conducted to test the candidate's intelligence, personality, and communication skills.
