

Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC)

The Rashtriya Indian Military College (RIMC) entrance exam is a highly competitive exam conducted twice a year by the RIMC, Dehradun. The exam is conducted to select deserving students for admission to the RIMC, which is an educational institution that provides pre-military training to boys from Class 8th to 12th. In this article, we will discuss the age and qualification criteria and the exam syllabus for the RIMC exam in India.

Age Criteria:

The age criteria for the RIMC exam in India are as follows:

1. Minimum age: 11.5 years
2. Maximum age: 13 years

Note: The age limit is calculated as on 1st January of the year in which admission is sought.

Qualification Criteria:

The qualification criteria for the RIMC exam in India are as follows:

1. A candidate must be studying in Class 7th or above in a recognized school at the time of admission.
2. The candidate must be medically fit and mentally sound.

Exam Syllabus:

The RIMC exam is conducted in two stages - Written Exam and Viva-Voce.

Written Exam:

The written exam consists of the following subjects:

1. English - 125 Marks
2. Mathematics - 200 Marks
3. General Knowledge - 75 Marks



Note: The Mathematics paper is set in English only.

Viva-Voce:

Candidates who qualify for the written exam will be called for the Viva-Voce, which is conducted to test the candidate's intelligence, personality, and communication skills.
